t3 is here! t3 (the teen timeline) is for all High School Youth, grades 9th through 12th, **t3** is the foundational teen Bible study based on the popular Great Adventure Bible Timeline. **t3** unpacks God's Word in a manner teens can relate to by showing them the "big picture" of salvation history, and it gives them an overview of Scripture—and then leads them deeper into its riches.
